Computer Skills

Learn how to navigate your computer and manage files when you download and save them.

Example Skills: Mouse use (Selecting text efficiently, Right clicking, Copy/Paste, Scrolling).
Navigating on a trackpad (below the keyboard on a laptop or Chromebook)

Internet Basics

Learn about the different Internet Browsers (Safari, Chrome, Internet Explorer, Edge, Firefox) and how to keep your professional and personal Internet traffic separate.

Example terminology: URL, Hyperlinks, Tabs, Pop-ups, Plugins/Extensions, The Cloud, Autocomplete & Saving Passwords.

Devices

Learn about the different devices being used in schools today. Reasons for their use and their differences.

Example terminology: Chromebook, Laptop, MacBook, Desktop, Tablet (Android, iOS), Solid State, Hard Drive, Interactive Projector (Smart Board)

Ports & Connections

Understand electronic devices and their connections to one another in your classroom.

Example terminology: VGA, HDMI, RCA, Mini Stereo, USB, Ethernet, Bluetooth, Wireless, Access Points.

NOTE: At least 2 must be registered for this event to take place.

This Bootcamp is **free for districts with PD contracts**. Contact your tech coordinator or treasurer if you are unsure whether your district has a contract. The non-contract fee for this six-hour Bootcamp is \$100.

Time earned can be applied toward CEU's or graduate credit through Ashland University upon completing 15 seat hours. The AU fee is \$200 for all participants pursuing graduate credit.
